PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 1 OF 1967

**A DECREE TO AMEND THE TRADES LICENSING DECREE
(Cap. 97, 1934 Revised Edition)**

IN EXERCISE of the Powers conferred by the Legislative Powers Law, 1964, the President for Zanzibar by and with the advice and consent of the Revolutionary Council hereby makes the following Decree:-

Short title.

1. This Decree may be cited as the Trades Licensing (Amendment) Decree, 1967, and shall be read as one with the Trades Licensing Decree.

2. The Trades Licensing Decree is amended by inserting immediately after section 8A the following new section to be numbered 8B:-

“8B. in order to promote greater local participation in the economy of the country, the Minister or Junior Minister, Trade and Industry may direct the licensing officer that for a specified type of business a licence may be issued only to a local person”.

PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 2 OF 1967

A DECREE TO AMEND THE AUCTIONEERS DECREE

IN EXERCISE of the Powers conferred by the Legislative Powers Law, 1964 the President of Zanzibar by and with the advice and consent of the Revolutionary Council hereby makes the following Decree:-

Short title.

1. This Decree may be cited as the Auctioneers (Amendment) Decree, 1967.

Addition of
new section
Cap. 165.

2. The Auctioneers Decree is hereby amended by adding the following new section immediately after section 27:-

“Prohibition
of auction
of movable
property.

28.-(1) Subject to the provisions of subsection (2), it shall be unlawful for any auctioneer to auction any movable property from the date of the coming into operation of this Decree.

(2) The Commissioner of Police may in any particular case authorise the auction of movable property.

(3) The provisions of subsection (1) shall not apply to the case mentioned in section 27 of this Decree”.

**A DECREE TO AMEND THE DRUGGIST DECREE

IN EXERCISE of the Powers conferred by the Legislative Powers Law, 1964 the President of Zanzibar by and with the advice and consent of the Revolutionary Council hereby makes the following Decree:-

Short title and
comencement.

1. This Decree may be cited as the Druggist (Amendment) Decree, 1967 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 7th day of March, 1967.

Insertion of
new section.

2. The Druggist Decree is amended by inserting immediately after section 27 thereof a new section to be numbered section 27A:-

“Restrictions on contra- ceptives. 27A.-(1) It shall be unlawfull for any person to import, sell or have in his possession for the purpose of sale any contraceptives, oral or otherwise.

(2) Every person having such contraceptives shall immediately deliver them to the Principal Secretary, Ministry of Health and Social Insurance”.

PRESIDENTIA DECREE NO. 5 OF 1967

**A DECREE TO ESTABLISH THE RURAL SETTLEMENT AND
VILLAGE DEVELOPMENT FUND AND TO PROVIDE FOR
MATTERS INCIDENTAL THERETO**

IN EXERCISE of the Power conferred by the Legislative Powers Law, 1964, the President of Zanzibar by and with the advice and consent of the Revolutionary Council hereby makes the following Decree:-

Short title and commencement.

1. This Decree may be cited as the Rural Settlement and Village Development Fund Decree, 1967 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1967.

Establishment of Fund.

2. There is hereby established a Fund under the name of the Rural Settlement and Village Development Fund, hereinafter referred to as the Fund.

Board of Trustees.

3.-(1) The President shall appoint a Board of Trustees (hereinafter referred to as the Board) who shall be responsible for the control and management of the Fund in accordance with the provisions of this Decree and of any Regulations made thereunder.

(2) The Board shall consist of a Chairman and three members.

(3) The Chairman shall be an official of the Government.

(4) The moneys paid into the Fund shall, so far as practicable, be invested by the Accountant-General on behalf of the Fund in such trust securities yielding interest as the Board shall approve.

(5) The Accountant-General shall keep a separate account of the moneys of the Fund and shall supply such information relating thereto as the Board from time to time may require.

(6) The Board shall submit to the President as soon as practicable after the end of each financial year, a full statement showing all receipts and payments.

(7) The accounts of the Fund shall be audited by the Auditor-General and shall be published in the Gazette.

Contribution to Fund.

4. The Fund shall consist of:-

- (a) such sums as may, from time to time be paid into it by resolution of the Revolutionary Council;
- (b) such sums as may be specifically raised by levies on income or profits; and
- (c) voluntary contributions thereto.

Purposes for which grants may be made from Fund.

5. Grants from the Fund may be made in accordance with the Provisions of this Decree for the development and improvement of the Rural areas, and in particular for:-

- (a) the establishment of Resettlement areas;
- (b) the development of existing villages;
- (c) the erection and repair of buildings;
- (d) the construction of roads;
- (e) the purchase of supplies and machinery required to plant, cultivate and manure lands and to reap and make merchantable the crop or produce thereof; and
- (f) any purpose that may be authorized by the Minister.

Development areas.

6.-(1) The President may by order published in the Gazette declare any area or village to be a development area (hereinafter referred to as a development area) for the purpose of this Decree. Such order shall specify the Minister responsible for the development of the area.

(2) Upon the making of such order every area shall be entitled to payments from the Fund for the purpose of undertaking its development.

Committees of Development.

7.-(1) There shall be established in respect of each development area a Committee of Development (hereinafter referred to as a Committee), with the Regional Commissioner of the Region within which the development area is situated as Chairman and 24 other members, one of whom shall be the Area Commissioner.

(2) The Committee shall after consulting with the inhabitants of a development area or the person to be effected by the development prepare a development scheme for its development area.

(3) Such scheme shall set out in detail the development proposed including the number of houses to be constructed, the number and category of roads to be provided and the nature of other facilities to be made available together with the estimated of the cost of the proposed development.

(4) On completion the scheme shall be forwarded to the Minister responsible for the development area who shall without delay forward it for the consideration of the Revolutionary Council.

(5) When the Revolutionary Council approves the development scheme it shall authorize the Board to make available to the Minister responsible for the development area the moneys necessary to implement the scheme.

(6) The Minister for each development area shall be responsible for the implementation and efficient fulfillment of the development scheme.

Regulations. **8.** The Minister may make Regulations generally for the better carrying out of the purposes and provisions of this Decree.

PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 6 OF 1967

**A DECREE TO APPLY THE UNION STATISTICS
ORDINANCE, 1961 TO ZANZIBAR**

IN EXERCISE of the Powers conferred by the Legislative Powers Law, 1964 the President of Zanzibar by and with the advice and consent of the Revolutionary Council hereby makes the following Decree:-

Short title. **1.** This Decree may be cited as the Statistics Ordinance, 1961 (Application) Decree, 1967 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of January, 1967.

Application **2.-(1)** The Union statistics Ordinance, 1961 as amended from time to time is
of Cap. 443. hereby extended to Zanzibar.

(2) The said Ordinance shall be construed with such modification not affecting substance as may be necessary to render effective in Zanzibar the provisions thereof.

(3) The jurisdiction, powers or duties incident to the operation of any of the provisions of the said Ordinance shall be exercised or performed in Zanzibar by the person or authority appointed under the said Ordinance.

(4) For the avoidance of doubts it is hereby specifically declared that an order made under section 5 of the said Ordinance shall have effect in Zanzibar if the order expressly or by implication provides that it shall apply to Zanzibar.

(5) Any Regulations made or any matter prescribed under the said Ordinance shall apply to Zanzibar.

Repeal of **3.** The Census Decree is hereby repealed.

PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 7 OF 1967

**A DECREE TO ESTABLISH A COMMISSION TO MANAGE
WAKF AND TRUST PROPERTY**

IN EXERCISE of the Powers conferred by the Legislative Powers Law, 1964 the President of Zanzibar by and with the advice and consent of the Revolutionary Council hereby makes the following Decree:-

Short title and commencement.

1. This Decree may be cited as the Wakf and Trust Property Decree, 1967 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of July, 1967.

Constitution of Commission.

2.-(1) There is hereby constituted a Wakf and Trust Commission (hereinafter referred to as the Commission) and such Commission shall be a body corporate and shall consist of:-

A Commissioner.
A Commissioner's Agent.
A Chief Kadhi.
A Resident Magistrate.
Five Members and
A Secretary to the Commission.

(2) Members of the Commission shall be appointed by the President.

Vesting of property.

3. There is hereby vested in the Commission all property of whatsoever nature which immediately before the Commencement of the Decree was vested in the Wakf Commission and all such property which was vested in the Public Trustee.

Common Seal.

4.-(1) The Commission shall have a Common Seal of such pattern as the Minister of Finance may approve.

(2) The Common Seal of the Commission shall never be affixed to any document except in the presence of the Commissioner or a member deputed by him and in pursuance of a resolution passed at a meeting of the Commission.

(3) Document under Seal made on behalf of the Commission, sealed with the Common Seal of the Commission and signed by the Commissioner, a member and the Secretary shall be deemed to be duly executed.

(4) Until an approved Common Seal of the Commission has been obtained the Common Seal of the Wakf Commission shall be the Common Seal of the Commission.

Meetings.

5.-(1) The Commission shall hold a meeting at least once in every month and at such times as the Minister of Finance may direct. At such meeting the Commissioner or in his absence a person deputed by him shall preside and shall have a casting vote.

(2) At any meeting of the Commission five members shall constitute a quorum.

(3) A copy of the minutes of every meeting of the Commission shall be transmitted to the Ministry of Finance soon after their confirmation.

Powers and duties of Commission.

6.-(1) The Commission shall exercise the powers and perform the duties exercised and performed by the Wakf Commission and the Public Trustee respectively and any powers and duties conferred upon it by any other law.

(2) Reference to the Wakf Commission or Wakf Commission in the Wakf Property Decree and to the Public Trustee in the Public Trustee Decree and the Public Trustee Rules shall be read and construed as references to the Commission.

Repeal of sections 3, 5, 6, 7 and 8 of the Wakf Property Decree.

7. Section 3, 5, 6, 7 and 8 of the Wakf Property Decree are hereby repealed.

Amendment of section 4 of Wakf Decree.

8. Section 4 of the Wakf Decree is amended by:-

(a) deleting therefrom subsection (1) and (2); and

(b) by renumbering subsection (3) thereof as section 4.

Repeal of section 2 and 3 of Public Trustee Decree.

9. Sections 2 and 3 of the Public Trustee Decree are hereby repealed.

Interpretation.

10. In this Decree:-

"Public Trustee" means the Public Trustee appointed by section 2 of the Public Trustee Decree;

"Wakf Commission" means the Wakf Commission constituted by section 3 of the Wakf Property Decree.

DECREE**

Short title and commencement.

1. This Decree may be cited as the Administrator-General's (Amendment) Decree, 1967 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of July, 1967.

2. The Administrator-General's Decree is hereby amended by inserting immediately after section 37 the following new section to be numbered section 37A:-

Amendment of Administrator General's Decree, Cap. 23.

“Administrator General to consult Commission No. 7 of 1967.

37A. The Administrator-General shall, in exercising any discretionary power vested in him as executor or administrator of a deceased estate, consult the Commission for Wakfs and Trusts established by the Wakf and Trust Property Decree, 1967 and he shall be bound by its advice.”

2. The Co-operative Societies Decree is hereby repealed and every co-operative society registered under the Decree is hereby dissolved and the assets and liabilities thereof shall vest jointly and severally in the members of the Society.

1. This Decree may be cited as the land (Distribution) (Amendment) Decree, 1967.

2. Subsection (2) of section 2 of the land (Distribution) Decree, 1966 is amended by deleting therefrom the words "signed by the President" and substituting therefore the words "bearing the signature stamp of the President countersigned by an authorized officer."

DECREE, 1965**

IN EXERCISE of the Powers conferred by the Legislative Powers Law, 1964 the President of Zanzibar by and with the advice and consent of the Revolutionary Council hereby makes the following Decree:-

Short title and
commencement.
Decree No. 11 of
1965.

1. This Decree may be cited as the Afro-Shirazi Party (Amendment) Decree, 1967, and shall be read as one with the Afro-Shirazi Party Decree, 1965, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of June, 1965.

Amendment of
section 8 of the
Principal
Decree.

2. Section 8 of the Principal Decree is amended by inserting immediately after the definition of "approved society" which appears therein a new definition as follows:-

"Income" in respect of an employee means his basic monthly salary."

PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 12 OF 1967

**A DECREE TO ORGANISE STATE TRADING THROUGHOUT
ZANZIBAR**

IN EXERCISE of the Powers conferred by the Legislative Powers Law, 1964 the President of Zanzibar by and with the advice and consent of the Revolutionary Council hereby makes the following Decree:-

Short title.

1. This Decree may be cited as the State Trading Decree, 1967

General
Council of
Trade.

2. -(1) There is hereby established a General Council of Trade (hereinafter referred to as the Council) consisting of the President as Chairman and the Minister of Finance, the Minister of Trade and Industries, the Minister of Agriculture and Land Reform and two other members to be appointed by the President from among the members of the Revolutionary Council.

(2) The Council shall appoint a Secretary to conduct its business but he should not be a member of the Council.

Duties of
Council.

3. The Council shall generally supervise State Trading and in particular it will:-

- (a) authorize the import of all classes of good specifying the nature and quantities of the good to be imported;
- (b) specify the country from which any particular goods will be imported;
- (c) approve the price at which the goods will be improved;
- (d) fix the prices at which the good will be sold in Zanzibar;
- (e) generally issue directions to Bizanaje for the efficient running of trade in Zanzibar.

General
Stores.

4.-(1) For the purpose of facilitation State Trading Zanzibar shall be divided into seven districts and Pemba into six districts.

(2) The boundaries of each district shall be decided by the Revolutionary Council.

(3) Each district shall have a General Store.

(4) The Revolutionary Council shall decide the place at which each General Store shall carry on business.

Duties of
General
Stores.

5.-(1) Each General Store shall be responsible for meeting the needs of the inhabitants of the District.

(2) For the purpose of ensuring that adequate stocks are maintained each General Store shall have a warehouse to maintain such stocks including reserve stocks.

Management
of General
Stores.

6.-(1) There shall be a Manager and an Assistant Manager for each General Store.

(2) The Manager and Assistant manager shall be appointed by the Revolutionary Council on terms and conditions to be decided by the Revolutionary Council.

General Stores
Committee.

7.-(1) There shall be an Advisory Committee for each General Store.

(2) The number of members of each Committee shall depend on the number of inhabitants of each district.

(3) Each district shall select its representative to serve on the Advisory Committee.

Duties of
Advisory
Committee.

8.-(1) It shall be the duty of every Committee to ascertain the needs of the inhabitants of its district.

(2) The Advisory Committee shall after ascertaining the needs of the inhabitants of the district submit to the Manager of the General Stores:

(a) the requirements for a month;

(b) the requirement for every three months;

(c) the requirements for a year.

(3) When submitting its requirements the Advisory Committee will specify in details the exact nature of the goods and the quantities for the different seasons of the year.

(4) The Manager of every General Store shall submit the list of requirements immediately on the receipt thereof to the Manager of the State Trading Corporation (Bizanje).

Particulars
to be
submitted by
Bizanje.

9.-(1) On receiving the list of requirements from the Manager of the General Store, the Manager of the State Trading Corporation shall forward the list to the Council.

(2) In submitting the list to the Council, the Manager shall forward to the Council particulars of:-

- (a) the different countries from which the required goods are available;
- (b) the price at which the good are available. These particulars shall include:
 - (i) the cost of goods in the country of origin;
 - (ii) the cost of insurance and freight;
 - (iii) cost of goods at the Zanzibar Customs;
 - (iv) the Custom duty payable;
 - (v) the final cost of the goods in Zanzibar including a sum of 6% as profit in the case of foodstuffs and a sum of 10% in other case.

Imports by
Bizanje.

10. No goods shall be imported by the State Trading Corporation (Bisaznje) without the approval of the Council.

Ban on
private
importers.

11. All import licences hitherto issued shall cease to be valid this Decree comes into operation. Any goods imported otherwise than in accordance with this Decree shall be forfeited and shall become the property of the Government.

Ban of
re-exports.

12. Goods imported into Zanzibar shall not be exported:

Provided that this ban shall not apply to-

- (a) Goods purchased at either the Airport Shop or the Shop in the Customs Area and which are supported by receipts issued by either of the above mentioned shops;
- (b) Appropriate wearing apparel and personal affects which are proved to the satisfaction of the Customs Officer to have been in the personal use of a passenger and which are taken out by the passenger as accompanying baggage.
- (c) Goods, the export of which is authorized by a certificate. For the purpose of issuing such a certificate there is hereby established a Committee to be called the Export Committee consisting of not less than three members to be appointed by the President.

PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 13 OF 1967

**A DECREE TO MAKE PROVISION FOR THE IMPOSITION OF
A LEVY IN RESPECT OF THE OCCUPATION OF
ACCOMMODATION IN CERTAIN HOTELS**

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by the Legislative Powers Law, 1954, the President for Zanzibar by and with the advice and consent of the Revolutionary Council hereby makes the following Decree:-

- Short title. 1. This Decree may be cited as the Hotel Accommodation (Imposition of Levy) Decree, 1967.
- Interpretation. 2. In this Decree, unless the context otherwise requires-
- "adult" means a person of or over the age of sixteen years;
- "hotel" means any establishment intended for the reception of travelers or visitors who may choose to stay therein and carried on with a view to profit or gain.
- Decree No. 1 of 1966. "Minister" means the Minister for the time being responsible for matters relating to the tourist industry;
- "Tourist Bureau" means the Tanzania Tourist Friendship Bureau established under the Public Enterprise Decree, 1966.
- Hotel levy. 3.-(1) Where any adult, in return for payment, occupies sleeping accommodation or obtain a meal in any hotel there shall be payable by such person a levy of two shillings in respect of each day or part of a day during which such accommodation was occupied by him or during which he obtained the meal.
- (2) The levy imposed by subsection (1) shall be collected by such persons and in such manner as may be prescribed.
- (3) All sums collected pursuant to this section shall be paid, by such persons, in such manner and at such intervals as may be prescribed, to the Accountant General.
