PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 1 OF 1968
A DECREE TO AMEND THE LAND (DISTRIBUTION)
DECREE, 1966

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by the Legislative Powers Law, 1964, the President for Zanzibar by and with the advice and consent of the Revolutionary Council hereby makes the following Decree:-

1. This Decree may be cited as the Land (Distribution) (Amendment) Decree, 1968, and shall be read as one with the Land Distribution Decree, 1966, (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Decree).

Short title

2. There shall be substituted for section 5 of the principal Decree a new section as follows:-

Decree No. 5 of 1966. Substitution of section 5 of principal Decree.

"Appointment of authorised officer".

5.(1) Every Agricultural Officer, Assistant Agricultural Officer, Field Officer and Field Assistant shall be authorised officers for the administration of this Decree.

3. The Principal Decree is hereby amended by inserting immediately after section 6 thereof the following new section to be numbered 7:-

Insertion of new section 7.

"Offence and penalty".

7. Without prejudice to the power contained in section 6 to terminate the grant, any person who fails to comply with any of the covenants laid down in section 4 or with the directions of any authorised officer shall be guilty of an offence and shall on conviction be liable to a fine of ten shillings for the first offence, twenty shillings for the second offence and one hundred shillings for the third offence".

PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 2 OF 1968

A DECREE TO AMEND THE PENAL DECREE

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by the Legislative Powers Law, 1964, the President for Zanzibar by and with the advice and consent of the Revolutionary Council hereby makes the following Decree:-

Short title
Cap. 13

1. This Decree may be cited as the Penal (Amendment) Decree, 1968 and shall be read as one with the Penal Decree.

Insertion of
new section
118A.

2. The Penal Decree is hereby amended by adding the following new section immediately after section 118 to be numbered Section 118A:-

"Abuse of
religion."

118A (1) where two or more persons assemble with intent to plot against the Government and so assemble under the pretext of being engaged in the performance of religious worship they shall be guilty of the misdemeanor termed "abuse of religion".

(2) An intent to plot against the Government shall be presumed if the following facts are proved:-

- (a) that the persons assembled in secret or in circumstances likely to arouse suspicion; and
- (b) that the place where the persons assembled is not a mosque, church, temple or other place of worship; and
- (c) that the effect of the words of any prayer recited by those assembled is likely to bring the Government of Zanzibar into hatred, ridicule or contempt or to promote feelings of ill-will and hostility against the Government.

(3) Any person who commits abuse of religion is liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding seven years".

PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 3 OF 1968

**A DECREE TO AMEND THE CONFISCATION
DECREE, 1964**

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by the Legislative Powers Law, 1964, the President for Zanzibar by and with the advice and consent of the Revolutionary Council hereby makes the following Decree:-

1. This Decree shall be cited as the Confiscation of Immovable Property (Amendment) Decree, 1968, and shall be read as one with the Confiscation of Immovable Property Decree, 1964.

Short title

2. Section 4 of the Confiscation of Immovable Property Decree, 1964 is amended by renumbering it as Section 4(1) and by adding the following New Subsection to be numbered (2):-

Section 4
amended.

“(2) These documents shall have no validity except for the purpose of supporting Government’s title to the property confiscated”.

PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 4 OF 1968

A DECREE TO AMEND THE WOODCUTTING DECREE

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by the Legislative Powers Law, 1964, the President for Zanzibar by and with the advice and consent of the Revolutionary Council hereby makes the following Decree:-

Short title and commencement. 1. This Decree may be cited as the Woodcutting (Amendment) Decree, 1968 and shall be read as one with the Woodcutting Decree (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Decree) and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 20th day of May, 1968.

Section 2 of the principal Decree amended. 2. Section 2 of the Principal Decree is hereby amended by deleting herefrom the definitions "Government land" and "wood" and substituting therefor the following definitions:-

"Government land" for the purpose of this Decree shall mean all land in Zanzibar except land disposal of under the provisions of the Land (Distribution) Decree, 1966;

"wood" means timber of mango or mangrove trees, fito, majengo, makombamoyo, boriti, mvule, mtondoo, msaji, mninga, mchapia tumbili, mwavi, ngulele, mjoho, mti mafuta, mvinje, msindazi, mzambarau, mfenesi, muembe, mchenza-mwitu, mkeshia, mkarafuu, mbura, msufi-mwitu, mnazi, mkerenge, msufi and any similar material used for building, boat-building, charcoal-making, or firewood and the timber of any other tree or species of trees which a licensing officer or an inspector may from time to time declare to be wood for the purposes of this Decree and shall include the bark of such trees."

Section 3 of the principal Decree repealed and replaced. 3. Section 3 of the Principal Decree is repealed and replaced by the following new section to be numbered 3:-

"wood not to be cut or removed. 3. Save as may be hereinafter provided (a) no person shall cut wood on Government land, and (b) no person shall remove wood cut on Government land from a recognised stacking place."

4. Section 4 of the Principal Decree is repealed and replaced by the following new section to be numbered 4:-

“Sale of timber on Government land. 4.(1) A Licensing Officer may approve the sale of timber on Government land on application being made to him in that behalf by any person and on payment of the prescribed fee.

(2) On approving the sale of timber on Government land to any person a Licensing Officer shall issue a Permit to cut wood and a Permit to transport wood in the prescribed forms.

(3) All wood cut on Government land shall be removed to a recognised stacking place as soon as possible after it has been cut and shall not be disposed of in any other way whatsoever.”

5. Section 9 of the Principal Decree is hereby repealed and replaced by the following new section to be numbered 9:-

“Fees” 9. The Minister may by Order prescribe the rate of fees to be payable in respect of any timber sold under section 4”.

6. Section 11 of the Principal Decree is hereby repealed and section 12 is renumbered as section 11.

Short title and commencement. 1. This Decree may be cited as the Commodities Control (Amendment) Decree, 1968 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 7th day of May, 1968.

Section 9 amended. 2. Section 9 of the Commodities Control Decree, 1966, is amended by deleting therefrom the definition of "Minister" and substituting therefor the following new definition:-

"Minister" means the Minister of Trade and Industries".

**A DECREE TO AMEND THE COMMODITIES
CONTROL DECREE, 1966**

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by the Legislative Powers Law, 1964, the President for Zanzibar by and with the advice and consent of the Revolutionary Council hereby makes the following Decree:-

1. This Decree may be cited as the Penal (Amendment) Decree, 1968 and shall be read as one with the Penal Decree (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Decree).

2. Section 248 of the Principal Decree is amended by deleting therefrom subsection (4) thereof and by replacing it by the following new subsection to be numbered subsection (4):-

"Stealing from the Government Decree No. 1 of 1968. (4) If the thing stolen is the Property of the Zanzibar Government (which expression shall include a Public Enterprise established under the Public Enterprise Decree, 1966, or a Company the shares of which are wholly owned by the Zanzibar Executive) the offender shall be liable to imprisonment for a term of not less than 2 years and corporal punishment not exceeding twenty four strokes."

The Industries Corporation Order, 1968

IN EXERCISE of the powers vested in me by section 2(1) of the Public Enterprise Decree, 1966. I hereby establish the following Public Enterprise with particulars thereof set hereunder:-

1. Name and Composition:

The Zanzibar State Industries Corporation (Shirika la Viwanda) which shall have the following sections:-

- (1) Production
- (2) Export, and local sales
- (3) Finance and Planning
- (4) Purchase

2. Minister Responsible

The Minister of Trade and Industries.

3. Objects:

(a) To organise and manage the following Industries:-

- (i) All coconut oil mills;
- (ii) All soap making factories;
- (iii) All coir fibre factories;
- (iv) All aerated water and ice factories.

(b) To encourage the export of coconuts and coconut products and for this purpose:-

- (i) either on its own behalf or as agents to deal generally in exports;
- (ii) to seek the most suitable markets for the local products of Zanzibar;
- (iii) to collect and circulate statistics and other information relating to its exports;
- (iv) to sell for home consumption its products;
- (v) to promote, establish and manage wholesale and retail stores for selling its products.

4. Head Office:

Mizingani, Zanzibar.

5. Nominal Capital:

The Nominal Capital of the Zanzibar State Industries Corporation (Shirika la Viwanda vya Serikali) will be four million Shillings wholly contributed by the Executive for Zanzibar.

1. Name and Composition:

The Zanzibar State Trading Corporation which shall have the following sections:-

- (a) Export
- (b) Finance
- (c) Purchase
- (d) Shipping

2. Minister Responsible

The Minister of Trade and Industries.

3. Objects

- (1) To take over the functions of the institution herefore known as the Clove Growers Association - subject to such alterations as enforced by these By-laws-together with all the assets and liabilities thereof.
- (2) To provide for, foster and encourage the production and marketing of the agricultural produce of Zanzibar and to encourage among agricultural producers the spirit and practice of thrift, co-operation and self-help and in furtherance of those objects:-
 - (a) either on its own behalf or as agents, to deal generally in and export agricultural produce;
