PRESIDENT DECREE NO. 1 OF 1970

A DECREE TO AMEND THE PENAL DECREE

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by the Legislative Powers Law, 1964, the President for Zanzibar by and with the advice and consent of the Revolutionary Council hereby makes the following Decree:-

1. This Decree may be cited as the Penal (Amendment) Decree, 1970. Short title

2. Subsection (1) of section 202 of the Penal Decree is amended by: Section 202 amended. Cap. 13.

(a) deleting therefrom the words "shall be guilty of the felony of child destruction, and shall be liable on conviction to imprisonment for life" and substituting therefor the words "shall be deemed to be guilty of the offence of murder, and shall on conviction be sentenced to death";

(b) deleting the proviso thereto and substituting instead the following new proviso:-

"Provided it shall not be an offence under this section if it is proved that the act which caused the death of the child was done in good faith by a doctor in a Government hospital for the purpose only of preserving the life of the mother and the fact that the act was so done is supported by a certificate signed by a team of at least two other doctors in a Government hospital."

PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 2 OF 1970

**A DECREE TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONDITIONS OF
APPOINTMENTS TO THE SENIOR CIVIL SERVICE
OF THE GOVERNMENT**

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by the Legislative Powers Law, 1964, the President for Zanzibar by and with the advice and consent of the Revolutionary Council hereby makes the following Decree:-

Short title

1. This Decree may be cited as the Senior Civil Service Appointments Decree, 1970.

Conditions for appointment to Senior Civil Service.

2. Appointments to the senior civil service of the Government shall not depend on a person's academic or professional qualification supported by a Degree, Diploma or Certificate. The criterion for appointment shall be the experience gained by a person, his practical knowledge of the work to be performed and his ability to perform the work with efficiency and diligence.

Appointment of special Committee to consider existing appointments.

3.(1) There is hereby appointed a Special Committee the members of which shall be appointed by the President.

(2) The Committee shall be empowered to consider all existing appointments to the senior civil service made solely on the strength of academic or professional qualifications supported by a Degree, Diploma or Certificate. And the Committee shall have power to adjust the salaries and the scales of the persons so appointed so that their salaries and scales accord with their experience, knowledge and ability to perform efficiently the duties of the post to which they have been appointed.

Issue of Government Certificates.

4.(1) Whenever the Government is satisfied that a person is capable by virtue of his experience, knowledge and ability to perform efficiently the duties entrusted to him a Certificate shall be issued to such person.

(2) Such Certificate shall be signed by the Minister for the time being responsible for Education.

5. This Decree repeals any existing law, rule or regulation which specifies academic or professional qualifications supported by a Decree, Diploma or Certificate, as a creterion for any appointment to the Senior Civil Service.

PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 3 OF 1970

A DECREE TO AMEND THE PEOPLE'S COURTS DECREE, 1969

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by the Legislative Powers Law, 1964, the President for Zanzibar by and with the advice and consent of the Revolutionary Council hereby makes the following Decree:-

Short title.

1. This Decree may be cited as the People's Courts (Amendment) Decree, 1970.

Decree No. 11 of 1969. Addition of new section 12A.

2. The People's Courts Decree, 1969 is hereby amended by adding immediately after section 12 the following new section to be numbered 12A:-

"Restriction Order." 12.A (1) Whenever a Court convicts a person for theft and sentences him to imprisonment the Court shall make a Restriction Order.

(2) The Restriction Order will restrict the convicted person for a period of one year beginning from the completion of the term of his sentence to an area within the village where the convicted person was born. In addition to so restricting the convicted person the Order will compel him to engage himself in farming activities within the village area.

(3) If a person violates a Restriction Order, by ceasing his farming activities or by leaving the area to which he is restricted before the completion of the specified one year he shall be imprisoned for the balance of the period of his restriction.

(4) If a convicted person originates from the mainland he shall be returned to the mainland and be prohibited from entering the Islands of Zanzibar or Pemba at any time in the future. In the event of his entering the Islands in violation of such prohibition he shall be guilty of an offence and shall on conviction be sentenced to imprisonment for a term of five years.

(5) It shall be an offence for any convicted person to give false information relating to his village of birth and he shall on conviction be liable to be imprisoned until he discloses the true place of his birth.

(6) While in restriction the convicted person may, with the approval of the Economic Council of the area to which he is restricted, receive the sum of sixty shillings as assistance to enable to maintain himself until the time of his first harvest.

(7) The Restriction Order shall be addressed to the Chairman of the Afro-shirazi Party Branch of the village to which the convicted person has been restricted."

PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 4 OF 1970

**A DECREE TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE
SUPREME COUNCIL AND TO DEFINE ITS POWERS**

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by the Legislative Powers Law, 1964, the President for Zanzibar by and with the advice and consent of the Revolutionary Council hereby makes the following Decree:-

1. This Decree may be cited as the Supreme Council Decree, 1970 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st of January, 1970.

2.(1) There is hereby established a Supreme Council consisting of a Chairman and eleven members who shall be appointed by the President and who shall hold office during the pleasure of the President.

(2) The Chairman shall appoint two Vice-Chairmen from among the members appointed either of whom will in the absence of the Chairman and at his request be able to preside at a meeting of the Supreme Council.

(3) The Supreme Council shall meet from time to time whenever it has business to conduct and the place of its meeting shall be specified by the President.

3.(1) The Supreme Council shall have power:-

(a) to hear and finally determine any appeal from a judgment of the High Court of Zanzibar; and

(b) to decide on any matter of public importance referred to it by the President;

Provided that no determination or decision of the Supreme Council shall have effect until such determination or decision as the case may be is endorsed by the President.

(2) Any determination of decision of the Supreme Council when endorsed by the President shall be final and no appeal shall lie from such determination or decision.

A DECREE TO PROVIDE PROTECTION FOR SPINSTERS

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by the Legislative Powers Law, 1964, the President for Zanzibar by and with the advice and consent of the Revolutionary Council hereby makes the following Decree:-

| Short title | 1. This Decree may be cited as the Spinsters (Protection) Decree, 1970. |
| Interpretation | 2. In this Decree:-
"Minister" means the Minister of Education;

"Special Committee" means the Committee established under section 6 of this Decree;

"Spinster" means a single woman but shall not include a widow or divorce. |
| Spinsters at school found with child. | 3.(1) A spinster who is found to be with child while still at school shall be expelled from the school.

(2) When any spinster at school is found to be with child it shall be the duty of the Headmaster or Principal to make an immediate report to the Minister and to the Regional Commissioner of the region in which the school is situate.

(3) The order of expulsion of the spinster found with child will be issued by the Minister through his Principal Secretary.

(4) A spinster expelled from a school will not be readmitted at any time in the future. |
| Duty of spinster found with child to name father. | 4.(1) It shall be the duty of every spinster found with child to disclose the name of the man alleged to be the father of the child and if such spinster refuses to disclose the name of the man alleged to be the father of the child, she shall be detained until she discloses his name.

(2) The order of detention shall be addressed to the Commissioner of Prisons and shall be signed by the Chairman of the Special Committee. |

(3) It shall be an offence for a spinster found with child to give any false information and she shall on conviction be liable to imprisonment for a term of not less than one year.

5.(1) If it is proved that the man who is alleged by a spinster to be the father of the child is in fact the father of the child he shall be guilty of an offence and shall on conviction be liable to imprisonment for a term of not less than five years with hard labour.

Father of the child of a spinster.

(2) After serving his term of imprisonment the father of the child of a spinster shall be compelled to pay half his monthly salary for a period of twelve months. The amount shall be paid to the Accountant General who shall maintain a separate account in respect of each child and shall hold it in trust for the child.

(3) In the case of a salaried employee it shall be the duty of his employer to deduct the amount from the salary of the employee and pay the amount to the Accountant General. The Chairman of the Special Committee shall notify the employer of the amount to be deducted from the salary of the employee. In any other case the Chairman of the Special Committee shall decide on the method of recovery of the amount payable.

6.(1) There is hereby established a Special Committee consisting of a Chairman and five members to be appointed by the President.

Special Committee.

(2) The Committee shall be empowered to do all that is necessary to give effect to the provisions of this Decree and in particular:-

- (a) to investigate every case of a spinster found with child and to sanction the prosecution of every person suspected to be guilty of an offence under this Decree;
- (b) through its chairman to order the detention of a spinster found with child who refuses to disclose the name of the man alleged to be the father of the child.

7. It shall be the duty of every Regional Commissioner and Area Commissioner to submit any report received by them that a spinster is with child to the chairman of the Special Committee.

| Short title and commencement. | 1. This Decree may be cited as the Appointment of Chairmen Decree, 1970 and shall come into force on the 1 st June, 1970. |
| Office of President. | 2. There shall be a President of Zanzibar who shall be the Chairmen of the Revolutionary Council and who may be referred to by either title. |
| Appointment of Chairmen of various sections of Government. | 3. The Chairman of the Revolutionary Council shall appoint Chairmen for the various sections of Government to undertake all duties for which they are responsible. |
| Powers of Chairmen. | 4. Every Chairman shall appoint:-
(a) a Deputy Chairman;
(b) an Assistant Chairman; and
(c) such Government officers as are necessary to carry out the duties and responsibilities of the Chairman. |
| Chairmen to be Members of the Revolutionary Council. | 5. Every Chairman and Deputy Chairman shall by virtue of their office be members of the Revolutionary Council. |
| Constitution. | 6. Reference in any existing law to:-
(a) a Minister shall be construed as a reference to a Chairman;
(b) a Junior Minister shall be construed as a reference to a Deputy Chairman;
(c) a Principal Secretary shall be construed as a reference to an Assistant Chairman. |

PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 7 OF 1970

**A DECREE TO AMEND THE EMIGRATION CONTROL DECREE,
1969**

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by the Legislative Powers Law, 1964, the President for Zanzibar by and with the advice and consent of the Revolutionary Council hereby makes the following Decree:-

Short title

1. This Decree may be cited as the Emigration Control (Amendment) Decree, 1970 and shall be read as one with the Emigration Control Decree, 1969, hereinafter referred to as the principal Decree.

2. The principal Decree is hereby amended by adding thereto the following new section to be numbered section 4A:-

Addition of

"Liability
of parent

child out of

exit visa.

4A.(1) Any parent who sends a way or who lets his or her child to go away in contravention of the provisions of this Decree and whose child has received free education in a Government school in Zanzibar will be liable to refund to the Government the cost of the education of the child.

(2) Such cost shall depend on the number of years spent at either a primary school, a secondary school or a teacher's training centre.

(3) The cost in respect of the number of years at these various educational institutions is specified in the Schedule to this Decree.

(4) Such cost shall be recoverable summarily before a People's Court. In case a parent is unable to pay the amount due in any case he shall be liable to a term of imprisonment calculated at the rate of three months for every year that his child received free education.

(5) The parent of such child will also be required to return the child to Zanzibar before a day to be specified by the People's Court. Failure on the part of the parent to do so will render the presence of such parent in Zanzibar unlawful and he will be required either to leave Tanzania or will remain in prison until the return of the child to Zanzibar."

PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 8 OF 1970

**A DECREE TO REGULATE THE CLOVE INDUSTRY OF
ZANZIBAR AND TO PROVIDE FOR MATTERS ANCILLARY
THERE TO**

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by the Legislative Powers Law, 1964, the President for Zanzibar by and with the advice and consent of the Revolutionary Council hereby makes the following Decree:-

- Short title. 1. This Decree may be cited as the Clove Decree, 1970.
- Interpretation. 2. In this Decree:-
"cloves" means the dried flower buds of the clove tree and includes mother of cloves and clove stems;

"the Corporation" means the Zanzibar State Trading Corporation established under the Public Enterprises Decree.
- Corporation to be sole exporter. 3.(1) No person other than the Corporation shall export cloves.

 (2) Any person who acts in contravention of the provisions of this section shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to ten years imprisonment and the exported cloves shall be forfeited to the Government.
- Sale of cloves direct to Corporation. 4. Every cultivator of cloves, owner or lessee of a clove plantation shall either sell his cloves direct to the Corporation or deposit them with the Corporation in accordance with the provisions of this Decree.
- Deposit of cloves with Corporation. 5.(1) The Corporation shall maintain deposit accounts of all cloves deposited with it in Zanzibar and Pemba.

 (2) When a person deposits cloves with the Corporation, the Corporation will issue him with a receipt stating the amount of cloves deposited with the Corporation.

(3) When a person wishes to sell his cloves to the Corporation he will have to produce the receipt issued to him and the amount sold shall be endorsed behind the receipt together with the balance, if any, which remains on deposit.

6.(1) With the permission of the Corporation a person may store cloves in his house or at any other place approved by the Corporation, When such permission is granted the following conditions will apply:-

Storage of cloves
at other places.

(a) A special permit will be issued signed by an authorised Officer of the Corporation stating the place where the cloves are stored and the amount;

(b) In case the person wishes to sell the stored cloves he will have to produce his permit. The amount sold and the balance stored will be entered on the permit and initialled by an authorised officer of the Corporation.

(2) Should there at any time be a discrepancy between the amount shown on an issued permit and the actual stock held by a person, he shall be guilty of an offence and shall on conviction be liable to imprisonment for a term of five years.

(3) A person who stores cloves in his house or at any other place without the permission of the Corporation required by subsection (1) of this section shall be guilty of an offence and shall on conviction be liable to imprisonment for a term of five years.

7. Any police Officer of whatsoever rank, officer of the Corporation or agricultural officer or any other person authorised by such officer shall have the power to enter upon and inspect without a warrant any premises where he has reason to suspect that the provisions of this Decree are being contravened.

| Short title | 1. This Decree may be cited as the State Goldsmiths and Silversmiths Decree, 1970. |
| Bizanje to have sole right to trade Decree No 1 of 1966. | 2.(1) Bizanje, a Public Enterprise established under the Public Enterprise Decree, 1966 shall have the sole right to carry on the trade of goldsmith and silversmith and such trade shall mean the carrying on of the trade of business of a dealer, trader or worker in articles of gold or silver respectively or in platinum or precious stones.

(2) It shall be an offence for any person other than Bizanje to carry on such trade and a person found guilty of such offence shall on conviction be liable to imprisonment for a term of five years or to a fine of twentyfive thousand shillings or to both such imprisonment and fine. |
| State shop and workshop. | 3.(1) There shall be a state shop in each of the towns of Zanzibar, Mkoani, Chake and Wete where articles of gold, silver, platinum or precious stones will be sold.

(2) In addition to these shops there will be three workshops in Zanzibar Town and two workshop at Chake where articles of gold, silver, platinum or precious stones will be worked, set otherwise prepared for sale. |
| Chairman responsibility. | 4. The Chairman of Trade and Commerce shall be responsible for the overall running of trade of goldsmith and silversmith and he shall issue general directions to ensure the proper and efficient running of the trade. |

5. The law relating to Goldsmith and Silversmiths contained in the Brokers, Hawkers and Goldsmiths Decree (Cap. 87 in the 1934 Laws of Zanzibar) is hereby repealed. Repeal

**THE MARRIAGE AND DIVORCE (MUSLIM) REGISTRATION
DECREE**

IN EXERCISE of the powers in him by section 22 of the Marriage and Divorce (Muslim) Registration Decree, the Minister hereby makes the following Rules:-

The Muslim Marriage and Divorce (Amendment) Rules, 1970
