**PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 1 OF 1974**

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**A DECREE TO AMEND THE SUPREME COUNCIL  
 DECREE, 1970**

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IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by the Legislative Powers law, 1964, the Chairman of the Revolutionary Council by and with the advice and consent of the Revolutionary Council hereby makes the following Decree : —

Short title.                    I. This Decree may be cited as the Supreme Council (Amendment) Decree, 1974.

 Section 2(1).                    2. Section 2(1) of the Supreme Council Decree, 1970 is hereby amended by deleting therefrom the word “eleven” appearing in the second line thereof and substituting therefore the word “fourteen”.

**REVOLUTIONARY COUNCIL DECREE NO. 2 OF 1974**

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**A DECREE TO RALLY TOGETHER THE PEOPLE'S OF ZANZIBAR  
 AND PEMBA AND TO MOBILISE ALL AVAILABLE HUMAN  
 RESOURCES TO COMBAT THE THREAT OF A WORLD FOOD  
 SHORTAGE BY INCREASING AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION  
 ON A PLANNED BASIS AND TO PROVIDE FOR MATTERS  
 ANCILLARY THERETO**

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by the Legislative Powers Law, 1964, the Chairman of the Revolutionary Council by and with the advice and consent of the Revolutionary Council hereby makes the following Decree:—

Short title.

1. This Decree may be cited as the Increase in Agricultural Production Decree, 1974.

Agricultural  
 Units.

2. For the purpose of facilitating control and ensuring a planned increase in agricultural production all agricultural activity will be carried out in one of the following units:—

- (a) Family or extended family units;
- (b) Co-operative units;
- (c) Party Branch units;
- (d) Youth Camp units:

- (e) Army unit; } - Armed Forces and
- (f) Police unit; } - Security units;
- (g) Education Centres units;
- (h) School units;
- (i) Government Department or Public Enterprise units;
- (j) Government Plantation units; and
- (k) Such other units that the Chairman may from time to time declare by order in the Gazette.

Council for  
Promotion of  
Agriculture.

3.(1) There is hereby established a Council for the Promotion of Agriculture consisting of the Chairman and not more than seven members appointed by the Chairman of the Revolutionary Council.

(2) The Council shall be responsible for the overall supervision of agricultural activity and in particular it will—

- (a) ensure that sufficient agricultural land is made available for cultivation to the various units and that units are allocated land in accordance with the overall production plan;
- (b) ensure a proper planning of the agricultural produce to be cultivated bearing in mind the demand for such produce
- (d) direct what cash crops should be planted in areas not utilized for food production;
- (e) provide mechanical services available on such conditions as may be prescribed by the Chairman;
- (f) provide units with all purpose services at regional, district and ward levels with specific reference to the use of fertilizers, insecticides, pesticides and other modern methods of cultivation which will result in increased agricultural production;
- (g) fix agricultural production targets for each year;
- (h) generally advise the Government on the best means of attaining the objects of this Decree.

(3) In allocating land to each unit the Council shall as far as practicable ensure that the land is near to the place where the members of the unit reside.

4. (1) There shall be an Agricultural Implementation Committee at the regional, district and ward levels consisting of the Party Chairman and Secretary together with the agricultural officer at their respective levels and not more than five other members. The Party Chairman at each level will be the Committee Chairman with the respective Party Secretary as the Committee's executive Secretary assisted by the agricultural officer at that level.

(2) Every Agricultural Implementation Committee shall be responsible for the efficient implementation of the provisions of this Decree within their respective areas and in particular, shall—

- (a) be responsible for the implementation of the programme at their level;
- (b) ensure that all available land within their zone or jurisdiction is cultivated by the proclaimed units in accordance with the plan and with a view to achieving the set targets;
- (c) check that production targets for each unit under their supervision is being met;
- (d) supply the Committee above it with progress reports on the number and types of units, the agricultural activity undertaken, achievements or short comings of the units within their zone.
- (e) Co-operate with all other committees in the task of ensuring production, collection, distribution and marketing facilities for agricultural produce; and
- (f) take adequate precautions to protect crops in any unit from theft, damage or destruction.

(3) Every Agricultural Implementation Committee shall submit its report to the Committee above through the Party ward, district or regional Secretary.



(4) The implementation Committee shall in each zone be responsible for the proper administration of agriculture within their area in accordance with the provisions of this Decree.

Obligation of persons to cultivate.

5.(1) Every able-bodied person not gainfully or productively employed or occupied shall immediately be required to enlist at his Party Branch for employment in any unit under the Ward Implementation Committee.

(2) Every able-bodied person who is gainfully or productively employed or occupied shall be required by his department, public enterprise or other institution to join in an appropriate Unit and make his contribution in the struggle for increased agricultural production.

Offences and penalties.

6.(1) Any person who fails to comply with the provisions of this Decree or who encourages another person to contravene the provisions of this Decree or who by any wilful act frustrates the aims and objects of this Decree shall be guilty of an offence and will be summoned before the People's Court.

(2) Any person found guilty of an offence under this Decree shall be liable on conviction to be sent to an Educational Centre for training as follows:—

- (a) for the first offence — for a period of six months;
- (b) for the second offence — for a period of nine months;
- (c) for the third offence — for a period of twelve months.

Interpretation.

7. In this Decree -

“able-bodied person” means in the case of a male, a person between the ages of 15 and 50 years, and in the case of female, a person between the ages of 15 and 45 years; other than a person exempted on medical grounds from physical labour.

“Chairman” means the Chairman for Agriculture and Land;

“Committee” means the Agricultural Implementation Committee established under Section 4 (1) of this Decree.

“Council” means the Council for the Promotion of Agriculture established under Section 3 (1) of this Decree.
